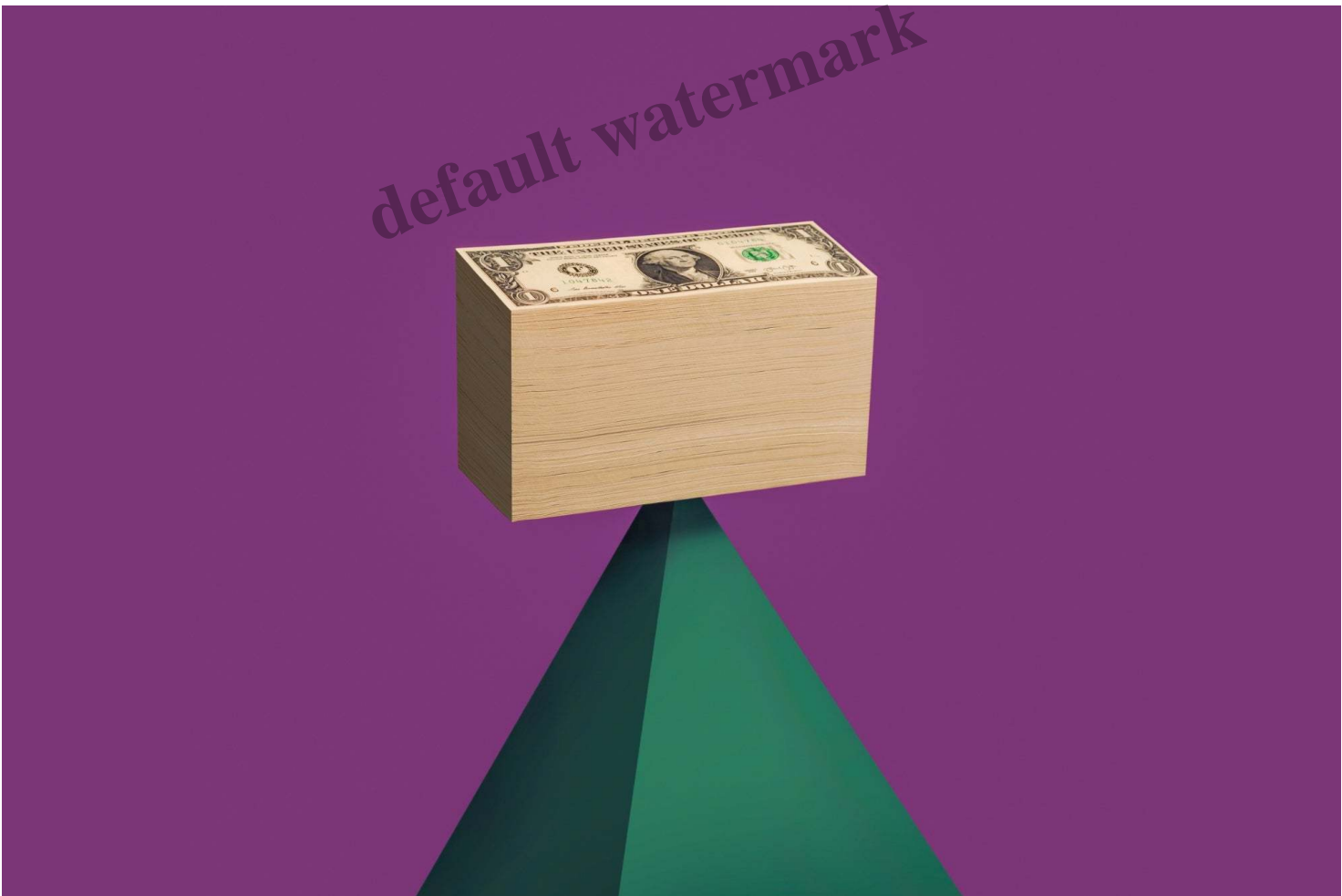




A Redditor Asked, 'What Do You Do That You Earn 6 Figures?' The Answers Might Surprise You.
